The City of La Crosse is seeking to hire a full-time Associate Planner in the Planning & Development Department. The purpose of this position is to assist managerial staff in initiating and carrying out planning studies and reports, neighborhood and community development activities, ordinance writing, and provide professional planning support to various City Committees and groups. The work is performed under the general direction of the Director of Planning, Development & Assessment and the Planning Administrator. Annual wage for this exempt position ranges between \$52,393.09 - \$60,004.41 depending on qualifications, with potential to earn up to \$68,721.45 through career advancement.

Requirements: Master's degree in Urban and Regional Planning, Geography, Public Administration or related field; up to one year of experience with exposure to planning principles. Geographic Information Systems (GIS) certificate helpful; or any combination of education and experience that provides equivalent knowledge, skills and abilities. Valid driver's license required.
